

Announcement from Bang Krathum Provincial Police Station Regarding anti-bribery policy (Anti-Bribery Policy)

According to the Organic Act on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption B.E.2561, Section 128, paragraph one, prohibits any government official from receiving property or any other benefits. which may be calculated as income from anyone In addition to property or benefits that should be obtained according to laws, rules or regulations issued by virtue of the provisions of the law. Except for receiving property or any other benefits in an ethical manner according to the criteria and amounts determined by the NACC and the Code of Ethics for Police Officials B.E.2564 Section 2 (2) Honesty. Perform duties in accordance with the laws and regulations of the Royal Thai Police Office. With transparency, do not show behavior that has implications for unfair exploitation. Be responsible for your human rights duties. Be ready to receive inspections and take responsibility and have good conscience. Be mindful of society and item 2(4). Think of public benefits more than personal benefits. Have public spirit, cooperate, join together, and sacrifice in doing good for the public and creating happiness for society. In addition, there is a plan to reform the country in terms of preventing and suppressing corruption and misconduct. (Revised Edition) Set important reform activities. Activity 4: Develop the Thai bureaucracy to be transparent. No benefits. Goal 1, Section 1.1: Have all government agencies announce that all government officials will not accept gifts and presents of any kind in the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy).

Therefore, in order to prevent conflicts between personal and public interests (Conflict of Interest), accepting bribes, gifts, or any other benefits that affect the performance of duties. Bang Krathum Provincial Police Station Therefore, guidelines for anti-bribery practiceshave been established. (Anti-Bribery Policy) has the following details:

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objective

1. To prevent or reduce the opportunity to receive bribes. Conflicts of interest in various forms for police officers under Bang Krathum Provincial Police Station.

2. To encourage police officers under Bang Krathum Provincial Police Station. Have a conscience in refusing to accept gifts and gifts of all kinds in the performance of duties.

3. To create an ethical and transparent organizational culture. (Organization of Integrity) of the bureaucracy to be strong and sustainable.

4. To determine measures, guidelines, and mechanisms to prevent giving/receiving bribes or any other benefits.

5. To determine guidelines for receiving entertainment fees. or gifts of executives and police officers under their jurisdiction Bang Krathum Provincial Police Station To comply with relevant laws and regulations.

6. To support and enhance operations under the national strategy, master plans under the national strategy. and the national reform plan for preventing and suppressing corruption and misconduct, including being part of the guidelines for evaluating morality and transparency in government agencies (Integrity and Transparency Assessment: ITA)

Scope of application

Applies to police officers under the jurisdiction. Bang Krathum Provincial Police Station, all officers

Definition

"Bribe" means property or other benefits given to a person to enable that person to do or Refrain from doing anything in your position whether it is legal or illegal. as the bribe payer desires Including receiving gifts. Facilitation fee A symbol of goodwill in accepting donations, adoptions, and similar benefits. When there is an offer, giving or receiving that can reasonably be considered a bribe, including giving or receiving afterward.

"Gifts, presents or any other benefits that affect the performance of

duties" means money or property. Any other services or benefits that are valuable and include tips. Government officials receive in addition to salary, income, and government benefits in

/normal cases...

normal cases and affect decisions, approvals, permissions, or anything else in performing their duties in a manner that benefits the provider in a dishonest way. gift Either in the past or while receiving or in the future.

"**Property**" means property and intangible objects. which may have a price and may hold it such as money, houses, cars, stocks

"Receiving property or any other benefits in an ethical manner" means receiving property or Any other benefits from relatives or people given on various occasions Usually according to tradition or culture or given according to etiquette practiced in society.

"Relatives" means parents, descendants, brothers and sisters. or sharing the same father or mother, uncle, aunt, spouse, ascendant or descendant of the spouse. Adopted child or adoptee

"Other benefits" means things of value. Including price reductions Entertainment Receiving training services or anything else of the same nature

"Performing duties" means an act or performance of duties by a government official in an appointed position. or has been assigned to perform any duties or to be acting on behalf of you in any duty, both general and specific, as a police officer whose powers and duties have been prescribed by law, or which are carried out in accordance with the powers and duties specified by law to have. Powers and duties of the police

"Commander" means a person who has the authority to order, supervise, monitor, and Check the officer Police officers under the jurisdiction

"Subordinate" means a police officer under his command. Bang Krathum Provincial Police Station Every officer besides the commander

Guidelines for preventing bribery

1. All police officers under the Bang Krathum Provincial Police Station are prohibited from being involved. In giving or receiving any form of bribe, whether direct or indirect.

2. All police officers under the Bang Krathum Provincial Police Station are prohibited from requesting or accepting bribes. For personal benefit or the benefit of others

/3. Follow the anti-corruption policy.

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3. Follow the anti-corruption policy. without getting involved in corruption Corruption, whether direct or indirect

4. The performance of duties must be carried out in accordance with regulations, police discipline and the law.strictly related

5. Do not do anything. that is considered giving or receiving a bribe

6. Supervise and ensure that the disbursement of expenses of affiliated agencies is in accordance with the law.Strictly related regulations

7.Receiving donations or support, whether in the form of money, objects, or property, for activities.or any project Must strictly comply with rules, regulations, and announcements. And there must be a receipt or evidence of receipt of money to accompany the report every time.

8. Receiving property or any other benefits with good ethics to police officers under the jurisdiction.Bang Krathum Provincial Police Station, all officers must comply with the announcement. Anti-Corruption CommissionNational Regulations on the criteria for receiving property or other benefits based on the ethics of officials, B.E. 2020strictly

Measures to manage policy violations

1. Violation does not comply with this policy. May be subject to disciplinary action or criminal prosecution or Other related laws Including direct supervisors who ignore wrongdoing or acknowledge that wrongdoing has occurred. but did not manage correctly which has disciplinary punishment up to the point of dismissal from government service

2. Failure to be aware of this policy announcement and/or related laws cannot be used as an excuse. In not being able to comply

3. Supervisors according to Police Department Order No. 1212/1994, dated October 1, 1994, have the authority The duty is to supervise and supervise subordinates under supervision to strictly adhere to and comply with this policy.

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Monitoring measures

1. Superintendent of Bang Krathum Provincial Police Station Announcement of intent to manage the agency. Honest, honest, transparent and in accordance with the principles of good governance. By disseminating public relations information to police officers under the jurisdiction. and external stakeholders know

2. The commander in accordance with the Order of the Police Department

No. 1212/1994, dated 1 October 1994, has the authority. The duty of supervising, monitoring, and inspecting subordinate police officers under their control is to conduct themselves in accordance with this announcement. In the case of finding an action that violates this announcement, report it to the Provincial Police Station Commander. Bang Krathum, please know quickly.

3. Bang Krathum Provincial Police Station Arrange for review and improvement of guidelines for compliance with appropriate or according to changes in various factors that are significant

4. To the administration department Bang Krathum Provincial Police Station Prepare statistics on receiving bribes or accepting bribes. Gifts or any other benefits from performing duties Along with problems and obstacles, report them to the commander of Bang Krathum Provincial Police Station. Know every quarter

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Measures to protect complainants/informers and maintain confidentiality

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1. Consideration of complaints Set the level of secrecy and protect those involved in accordance with the regulations. Maintaining government secrets 2001 and submitting matters to the agency for consideration The informant and the complainant may be in trouble, for example, a complaint against a government official is initially considered a government secret. If it's a cool card Consider only the cases with specified evidence. The surrounding circumstances are clearly evident. as well as pointing out personal witnesses Only definitely Reporting information on influential people must conceal the name and address of the complainant. If the name and address of the complainant is not concealed, Notify the relevant agencies and provide protection to the complainant as follows: "Let the commander use his discretion to give orders. as appropriate to protect the complainant, witnesses, and persons providing information in the investigation Don't let yourself suffer danger or suffering. Unfairness that may result from complaints being a witness or providing that information" in the case where the name of the accused is specified Must protect both the complainant and the respondent. Because the matter has not yet gone through the fact-checking process. And it may be bullying and accusations that will cause suffering and damage. and in the case where the complainant specifies in the complaint Request concealment or do not wish the complainant's name to be disclosed. The agency must not reveal the name of the complainant to the responding agency. This is because the complainant may have suffered as a result of the complaint.

2.When there is a complaint The complainant and witnesses will not be subject to any action. that affects work or life. If it is necessary to take any action, such as separating the workplace to prevent the complainant, the witness, and the accused from meeting together, etc., consent must be obtained from the complainant and the witness.

3. Requests from the injured party, the complainant, or witnesses, such as requests to move workplaces. or methods for Prevent or solve problems Should be considered by responsible persons or agencies as appropriate.

4. Provide protection to the complainant from being harassed.
